PRAYER THIS WEEK

'Trust in him at all times, O people: pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us' (Psalm 62 v.8)

SUNDAY Pray for those in need of God's healing, especially for Robin G, George I and Jenny W (all receiving cancer treatment and care). Pray for those recently bereaved including the families and friends of David G, Jackie B and Jennie N (funeral on 16 June).

MONDAY Give thanks for the Summer Fair last Saturday - for the money raised towards the children and youth work in our two parishes; for those who helped on stalls and serving refreshments; for those living in the area who came into our buildings, perhaps for the first time. Pray that we will be able to build on those contacts in the months ahead.

TUESDAY This is a long half-term and many students have exams at school or university. Pray for those sitting important exams, especially those who find them stressful. Remember school staff and examiners as they mark papers, often with deadlines to meet.

WEDNESDAY The massacre of at least ten students at the school in Austria last week left many others injured. Pray for the families of those who lost their lives and for those traumatised by the event. Pray too for those involved in the violence in Los Angeles - the injured police, those whose property was looted and vandalised, and the authorities as they restore law and order.

THURSDAY Sadly the father of our newly-appointed cleaner Laura has died whilst they had gone back to Italy on holiday, and she has had to terminate her contract. Pray for Philip Clayton as he temporarily covers the cleaning of our church and hall, and for a quick solution to the need for a cleaner. Pray for Laura too as she mourns the loss of her father.

FRIDAY Today we pray for people living in Turnberry, Tenison Court and Unthank Road, praying especially for new residents as they make friends. Pray too for businesses and shops in Eaton as they face the additional staffing costs in line with government legislation.

SATURDAY *"Church Mission Society Global Mission Through Local Leaders scheme has helped translate the Bible into indigenous languages in Latin America. They work among at-risk youth, lead churches, make disciples and equip Christian leaders for holistic mission.
